F. Substitute Teacher:

J. Albus moved to hire Heidi Miller as a substitute teacher. Second: C. Hillman. Passed: 5/0.

G. Non-voted Transportation Levy:

C. Hillman moved for an increase in local taxes to support the elementary transportation fund in the amount of \$19675.00 which is approximately 5.27 mills for the purpose of salaries and benefits, bus maintenance and increase cost of operation. Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$7.11 and on a home with a market value of \$200,000 by approximately \$14.23. Second: J. Albus. Passed: 5/0

C. Hillman moved for an increase in local taxes to support the high school transportation fund in the amount of \$19452.00 which is approximately 4.25 mills for the purpose of salaries and benefits, bus maintenance and increase cost of operation. Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$5.74 and on a home with a market value of \$200,000 by approximately \$11.48. Second: J. Albus. Passed: 5/0
